Anakudluk Inuqtaqua says applying for a job at Mary River was the best decision she ever made. The Iqaluit woman, who works as an Administrative Assistant with Site Services, says everyone is helpful and supportive, she loves the work-life balance of rotation work, and while camp life can be hard by week 3, having amazing coworkers makes all the difference.

After 10 years of administrative work with the Government of Nunavut, Anakudluk says she was tired of the 9 to 5 life, found the weekends too short, and she wanted adventure. So when friends told her Baffinland was a good place to work, she applied online, did a phone interview, and got the job.

She says the vibe is good at site, where supervisors take her seriously and listen to her concerns. She also says her Inuit coworkers, some of whom are shy, will open up to her, and she likes helping others so much, she now hopes to move to site HR. Another thing she likes is that Baffinland has created Inuit Success Teams, who sit down with each Inuit employee, asking about their short- and long-term career goals, and then offering help to achieve those goals.
